





This provides a better ease of view and immediately creates a round, clear image without any shading and vignetting. This allows a fast and safe shot – in driven hunts as well as from high seats. Thanks to the special eyepiece design of the Leica riflescopes, at a 1x magnification the exit pupil is 50% larger than in other products of its class.

The wide-angle field of view of the Leica riflescopes offers hunters the greatest possible overview for a safe and ethical shot. It gives hunters more safety, especially at narrow forest aisles and in difficult terrain. 
